

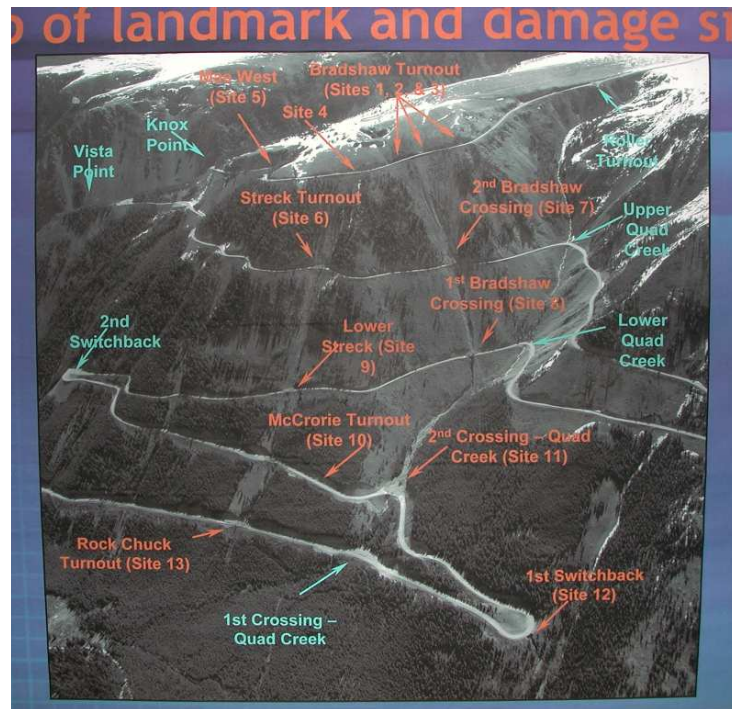
# PLANS DO CHANGE
