**The most interesting thing about Watson Lake, in fact the only interesting thing about Watson Lake is the Sign Forest. Started years ago, it now has about 72,000 signs. Folks used to make a wooden sign on a small board with their name and town painted on it, and nailed it to the posts. Now they just steal a home town sign from where they live and post it with no names that can be traced for theft!**



**It supposedly is the third largest city in the Yukon Territory with 1,000 some residents.**

**After staying the night, it was a springboard for our drive down the Cassiar Highway, to Stewart, BC and Hyder, AK. These two towns are very isolated.**
