Satisfied by mussel meals in So. Calif., we were pointed to WA. and the Penn Cove mussel.

The Coupeville bar and grill, Toby's, which has been there since the 1890's, has become world famous for their mussels. The Honda just fit the space in front, and in we went.



The \$13 order of Penn Cove mussels contained 30-35 shells and the mussels were huge! Compare this with our Red Lobster order of 19-21 mussels for \$14. This is the first time I have been full after a meal of these.

By the way, we are staying at the La Conner Thousand Trails Preserve for 9 nights. There are lots of Blackberries this year and so far the ones we have eaten are worm free. (soak them in salted water to make them crawl out)
