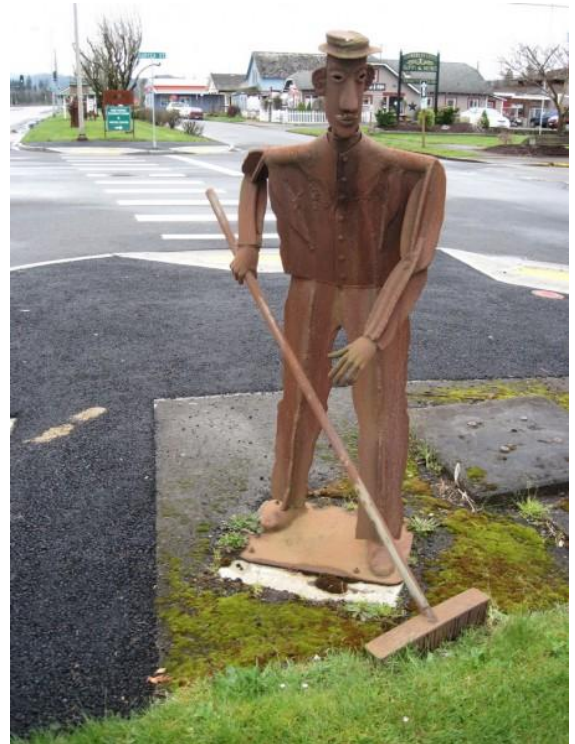


MOVIN ON!
