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## WE THINK SUMMER HAS ARRIVED

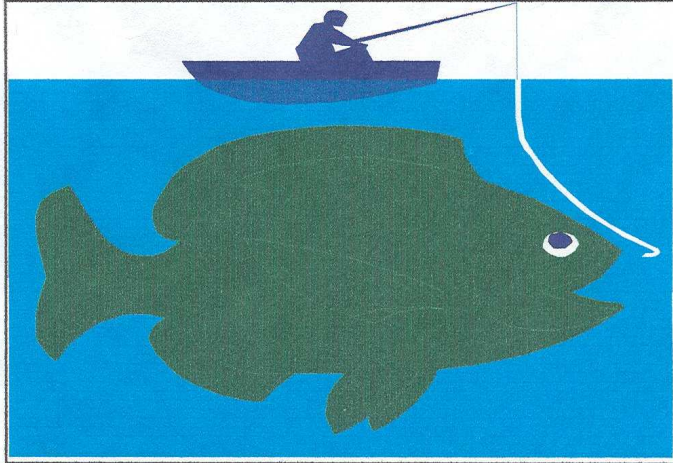
**W**e got up early and left the park about 8:00 AM and headed for the Border. Before crossing we stopped to gas up at low \$1.41 gal price.
