Our first stop was at the highly touted Big Horn Restaurant. (El Dumpo!) Just because it's in the Milepost doesn't mean it is any great place!

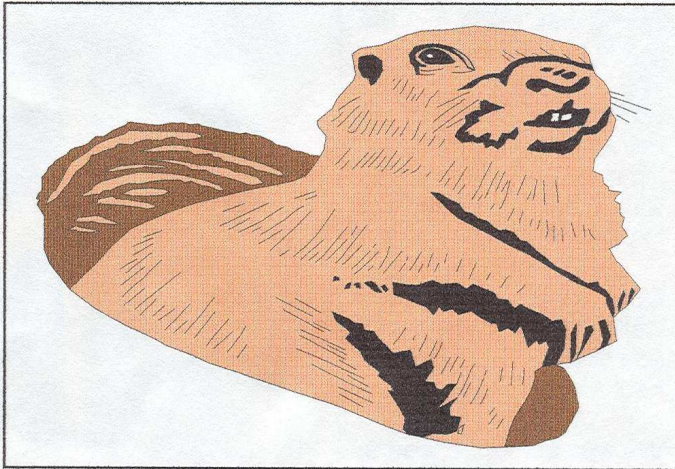
We next stopped at the historic Ashcroft Manor and had our morning tea. Then headed into the town itself. (3 streets)!
