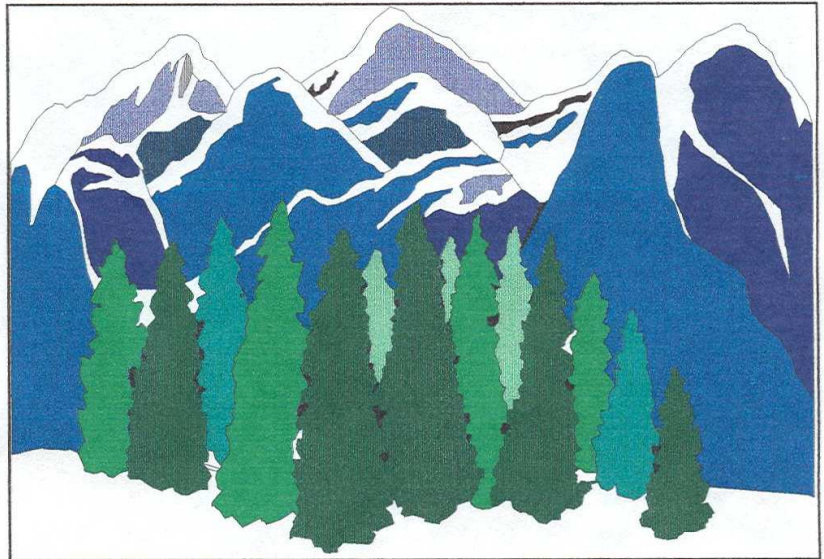
WE BEAT THE CASSIAR! (WE DIDN'T GO)
