**W**e left the grassy field and drove an uneventful 92 miles to Dawson City on the Yukon River.

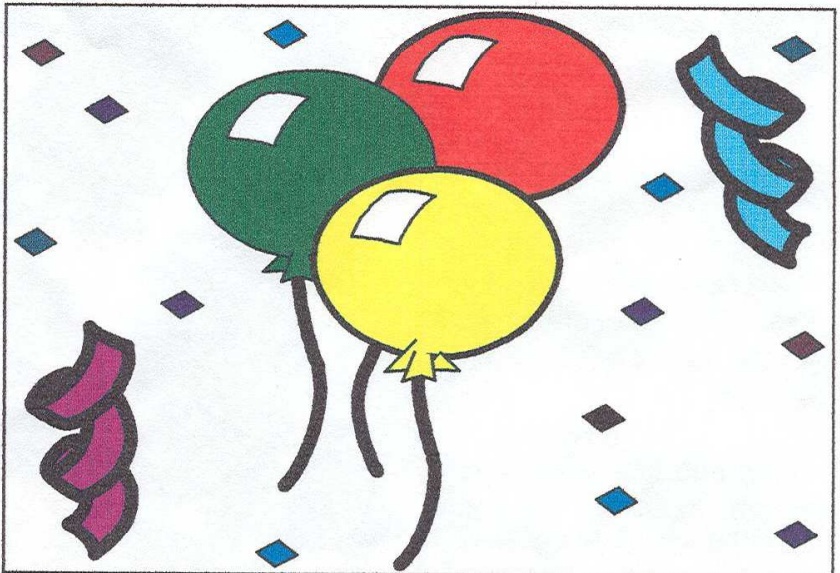
After all that was said about it , it still is a little dumpy town. Gasoline works out to be about \$2.25 a gallon US.
