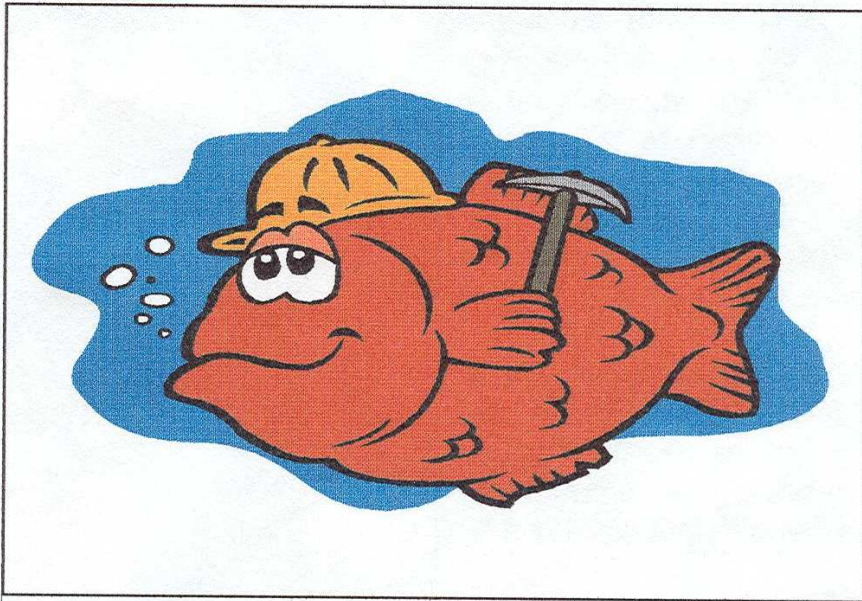
Gene, Maxine and Dave took the Alyeska pipeline plant tour which was very interesting and technical.
