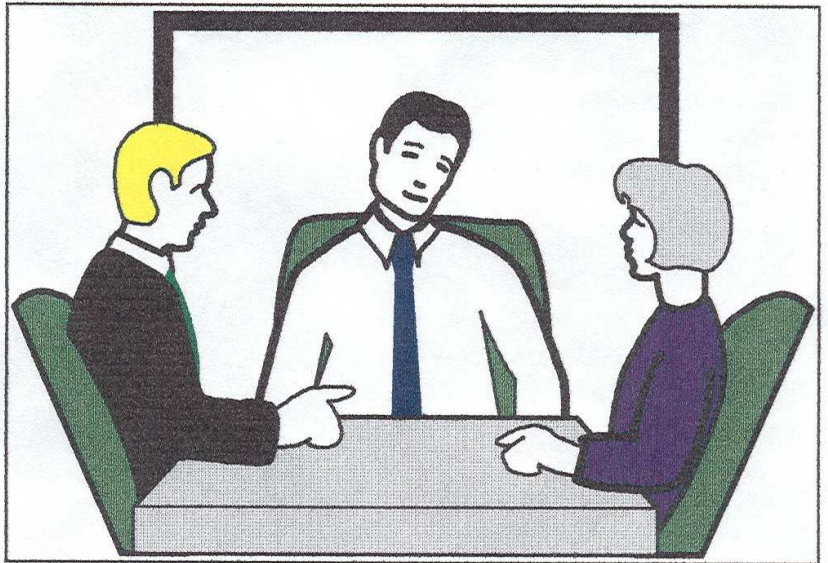
A GOOD DAY WITH OLD FRIENDS !
