his morning we left Anchorage, Gene and Maxine and the Suters. It was about 235 miles to Denali where we will meet the Lowrys.


We took a side trip to Talkeetna where we looked up some friends of June Burton. They operate the Fairview Inn, vintage 1923. They were nice people.
