We arrived at Skagway at 1:30AM and sleepily drove the city streets until we parked in front of a house for the rest of the night.

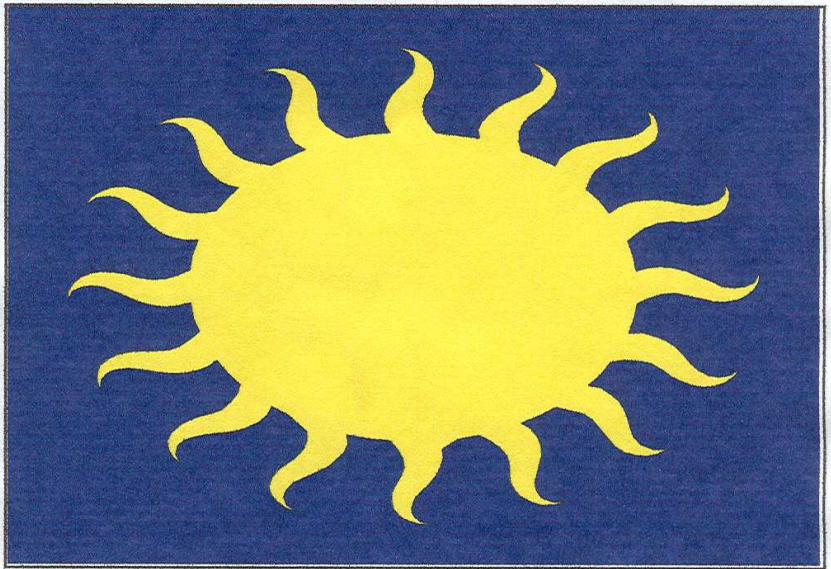
