**S** quanga Lake campground became the pinnacle of the animal scene this morning.

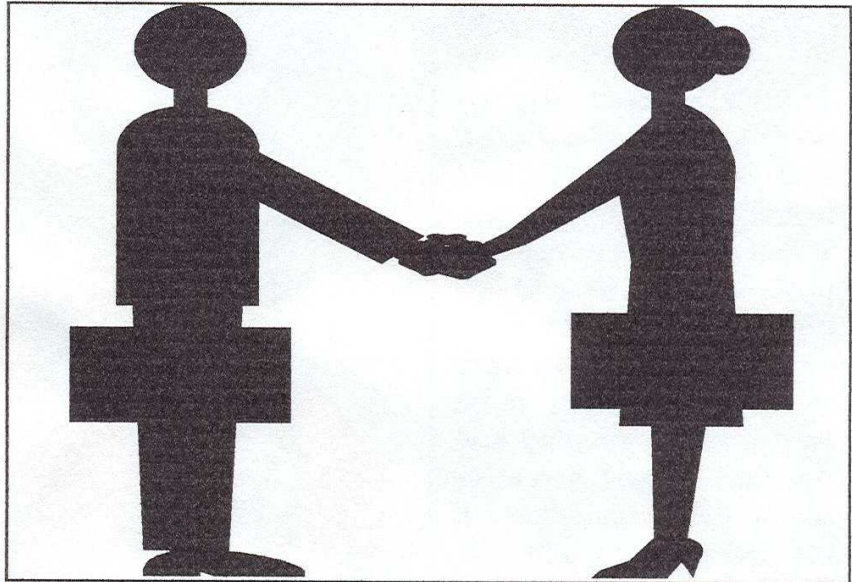
