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## FOLKS THROWN OUT OF BC PARK!

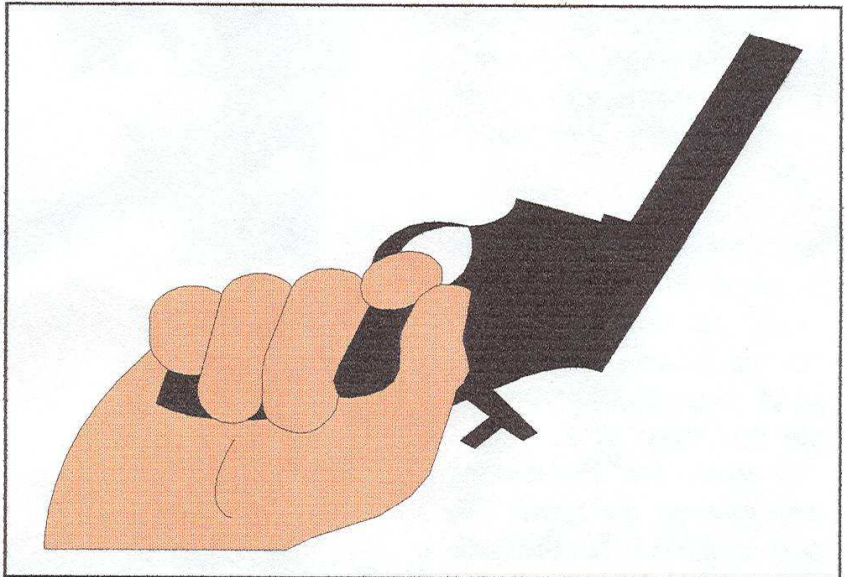
**T**oday we prepared for the dreaded Cassiar highway. We got up early, spotted a Moose and a Bear cub, and forged on.
