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FINALLY: A RELAXING DRIVE!

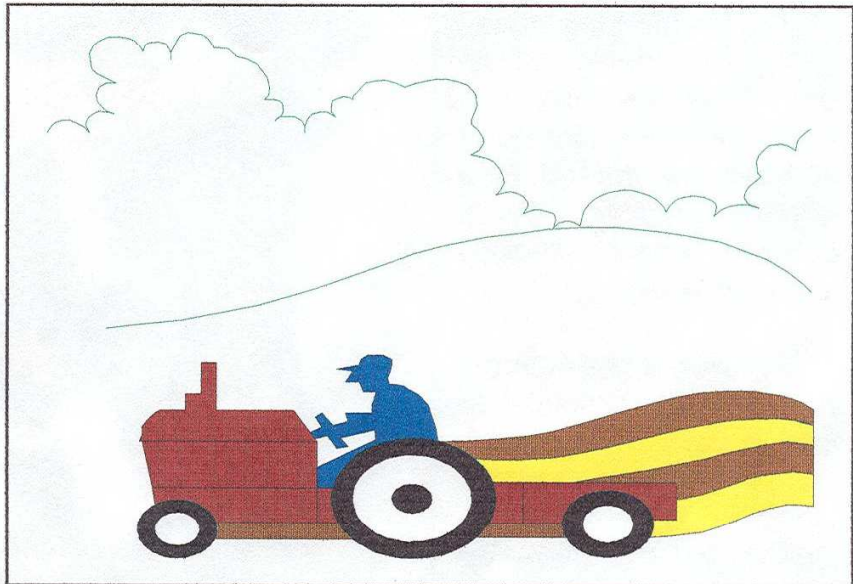
We left real early from the Morice Campground. There were 240 miles to Prince George and the RV repair place.
