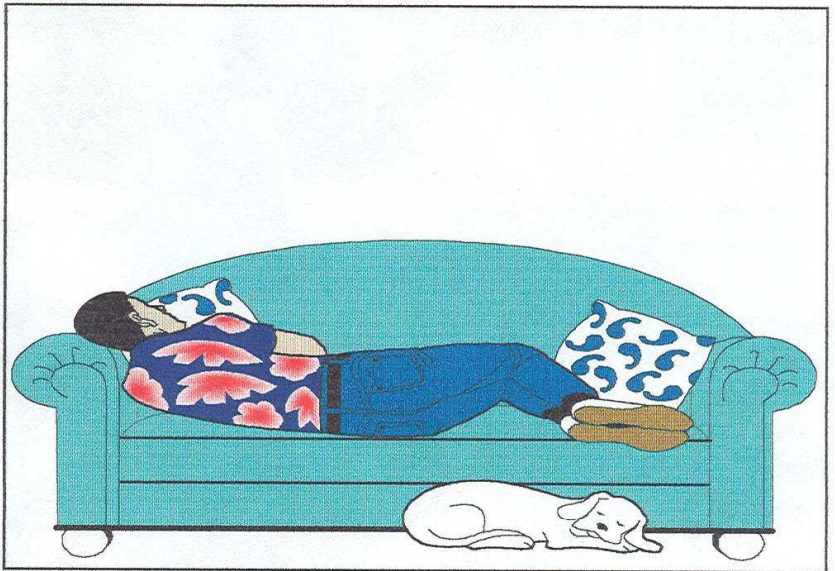
By the time he fixed that, they decided to stay another night.
