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A RED LETTER DAY FOR ANIMALS!

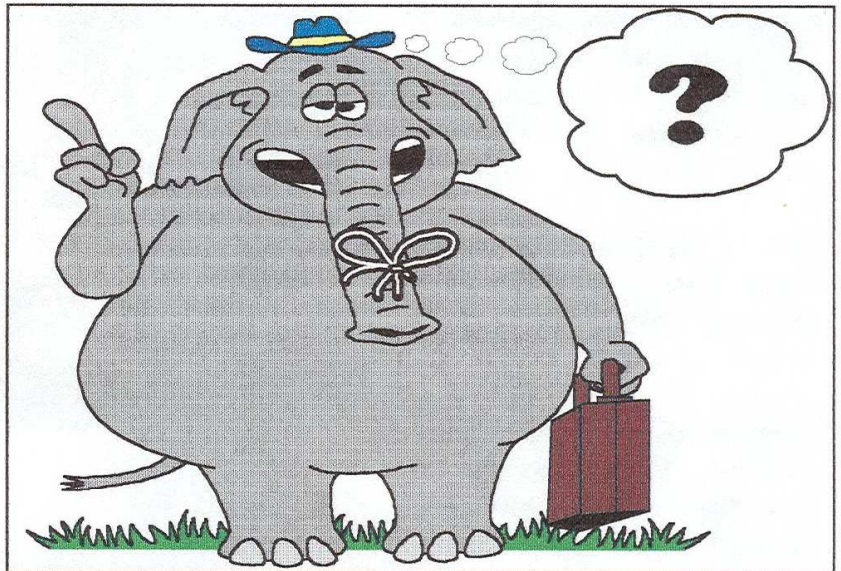
Ready or not we leave for Jasper Park and City.
