DEJA-VOUS BACK TO JASPER!

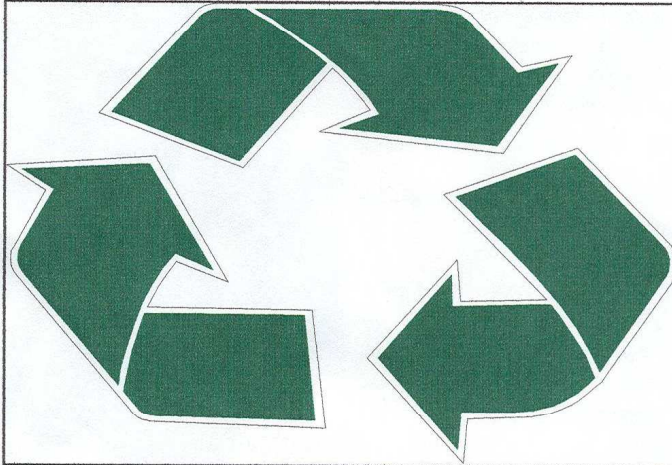
It appears that we drove 400 some miles to see a mall! Well, it was something to see.
