Repeating the route from Edmonton we arrived in Jasper and camped in a new campground named Wabasso.

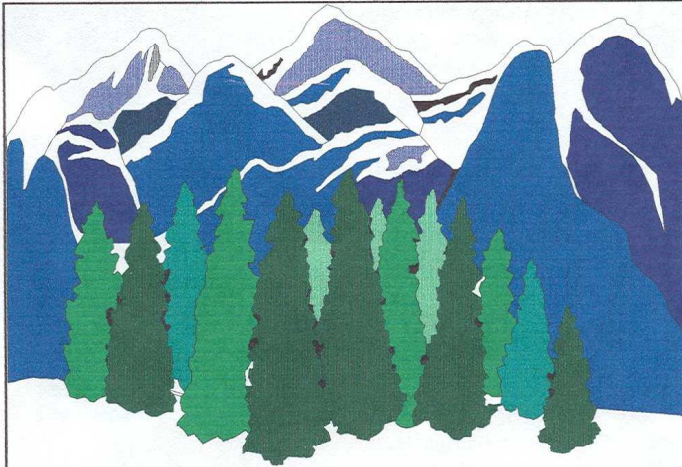
We left early with a lot to see today.
