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WELCOME BACK TO THE USA!

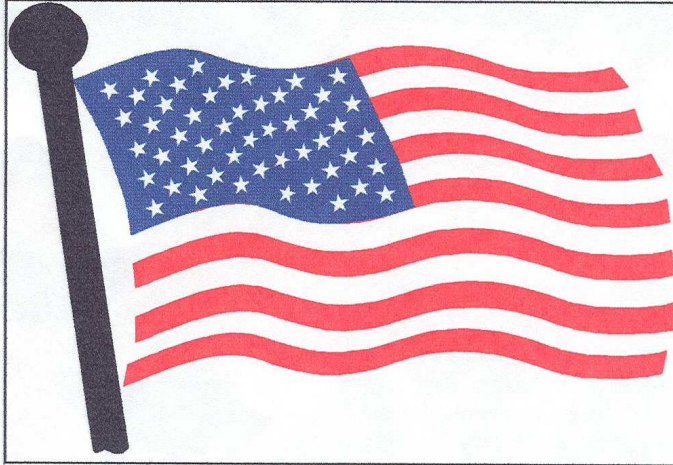
Saying goodby to Banff and the area, we backtracked to Castle Junction, and then on the road to Radium Hot Springs and Kingsgate.
