Leaving beautiful Three Islands Camp early, we drove the scenic route 30 along the Snake River and it's gorges. Much better than the Interstate!

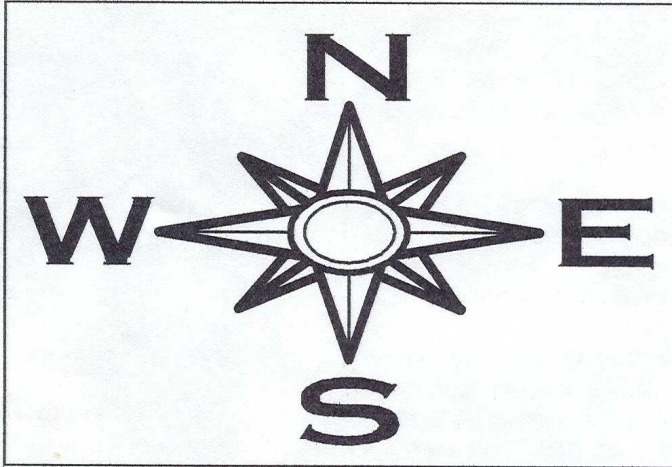
We drove thru Twin Falls and went to Shoshone Falls. These are supposed to be higher than Niagara Falls. They were quite a sight!
